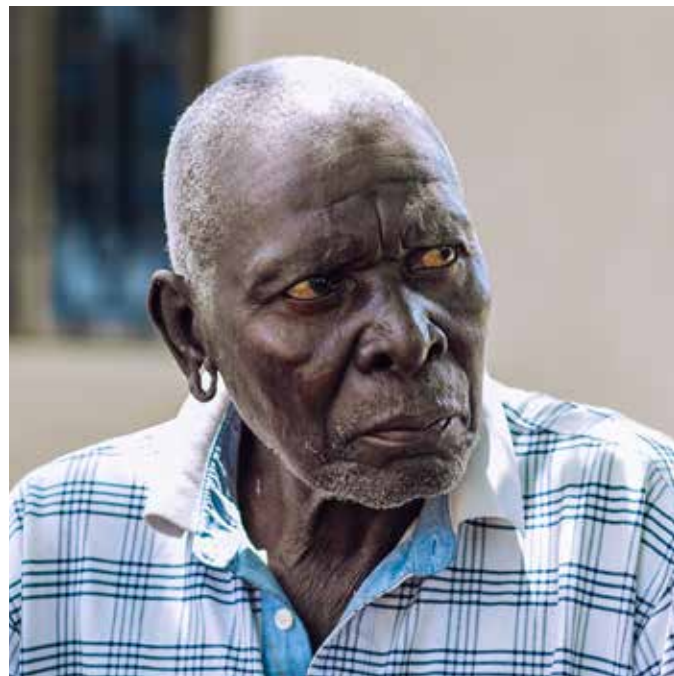
Our wazee, with the help of their caretaker, will be able to look after mama Loy and improve their lives through keeping active and getting fresh milk.

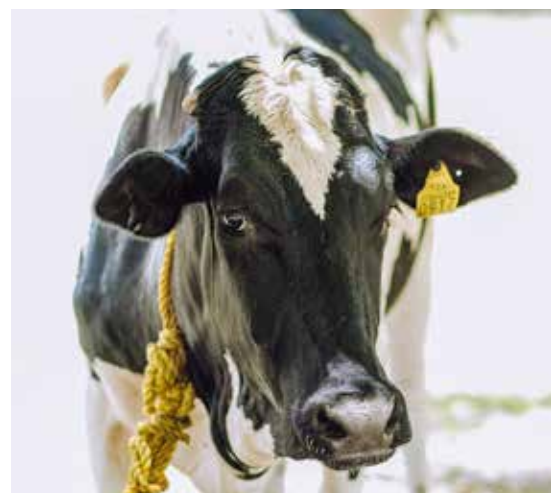
